The elections for the EAPM Board, held every two years, are approaching. On 17 September 2026 in Warsaw, during the General Assembly, we will elect our representatives to the new Board for the next two years. The terms of the electoral process, according to our statutes, are available on our website.

Professor Neena Modi will continue her activities on the new Board as Immediate Past President, and I will assume the role of President. The election will therefore concern the remaining positions: President-Elect, Secretary General, Treasurer, and six Board members.

With this letter, I would like to inform all potential candidates about the functioning of the next Board and the expected commitment. Board members are expected not only to attend meetings but also to actively contribute to EAPM's work, participate in discussions, support agreed-upon initiatives, and collaborate with fellow members to advance the Association's objectives.

The following meetings are foreseen:

- The five officers will hold a monthly online meeting, lasting one hour, on a fixed date and time.
- All Board members will participate in an online meeting every two months, lasting 90 minutes, on a fixed date and time.
- An annual in-person meeting for all Board members will be held over two days, on a fixed date and at a location to be determined.

The schedule for all meetings will be determined during the inaugural meeting of the new Board.

I encourage all eligible members who wish to contribute actively to the future work of EAPM to submit their candidacies. I extend my best wishes to all candidates and look forward to a productive collaboration.
